Campus Life Leadership Development programs prepare students for leadership opportunities by exposing them to styles, theories and models of leadership while challenging them to think critically about their own leadership potential and how to apply it in their academic life, extracurricular activities, and subsequent career endeavors.

The **LOCH IN**stitute is Campus Life's premiere leadership development program. LOCH-IN is a comprehensive non-credit certificate course designed to teach students the most formidable leadership skills for success in leadership on campus, in communities, and in career endeavors. Student outcome objectives of this program include: **L**eadership skills, conventional theories and best practices of leadership into practical application; **O**wnership of leadership style and philosophy; **C**onnect cross-cultural perspectives on leadership to personal values and create a more inclusive community; and **H**elp others in the community through service and social responsibility.

Program Requirements

If selected to participate in LOCH IN, students will be required to complete the following components:

- Attend six class sessions (*fourth Tuesday of each month beginning September 22, 2009*)
- Attend at least three LEAD the Way Seminars
- Participate in one Service Learning Series per semester
- Attend the Diversity Conference, October 16, 2009
- Attend the Student Leadership Conference, April 9-11, 2010
- Develop an action plan to apply learned leadership skills in academic life, campus involvement opportunities and daily interactions
- Complete all other assignments as required of the program

Program Eligibility

All Clayton State University matriculating students are eligible to participate in the program. Priority selection will be given to:

- Current student leaders of campus organizations or programs
- Students who demonstrate a desire to become a student leader in a campus organization
- Students who exemplify independent thinking and decision-making skills

The Application Deadline for LOCH-IN is September 4, 2009!
