

Career Opportunities Fair Q&A

Q: Who can attend the Career Opportunities job fair?

A: Students and graduates from Clayton State University and from other participating institutions with the Georgia Careers Consortium.

Q: Is there a registration fee or cost to attend?

A: There is no cost for the career fair to students and graduates associated with the Georgia Careers Consortium member institutions.

Q: I have attended other job fairs. Why should I attend this one?

A: Career Opportunities is different from public job fairs that invite all community members. Employers attend Career Opportunities in order to connect specifically with **college** students and graduates. This is a unique opportunity for you to network with employers in a professional setting that is not as crowded as community job fairs.

Q: What should I bring to the job fair?

A: You must bring your college I.D. (current students) and resume. See link on *Tips for Attending*: <http://home.lagrange.edu/gcc/tipsforattending.htm>

Q: How can I prepare for the career fair?

A:

- Review participating employer information
- Visit employer web sites to learn more about them
- Determine which organizations you want to target at the fair
- Plan your 60-second introduction of yourself
- Come to the fair with copies of your resume and questions for the recruiters

Q: Can we arrive early?

A: Yes, you may arrive early, but the doors will not open until 12pm. The Career Fair Success workshop starts at 11am.

Q: How do I get to the career fair?

Q: How do I dress for the Career Fair?

A: We **require** that you dress professionally (business attire) for the job fair. No jeans, sneakers, workout/gym clothes or short midriff shirts. If you have any questions about business attire, stop by the Office of Career Services to see examples.

Q: Is parking free?

A: Yes.

Q: Whom do I contact if I need reasonable accommodations?

A: Contact your Career Services Office or Disability Resource Center.

When you arrive at the career fair you will find ample handicapped parking in front of the main entrance. If the spaces are full, additional handicapped parking can be found outside the east entrance. Please see the Cobb Galleria's for the exact locations. Persons with disabilities can be dropped off in the rotunda area of the main entrance. Sloped ramps can be found at the main entrance, and the far left doors are wheelchair accessible. All of Cobb Galleria Centre's event space is located on one level. From the rotunda, take the elevator to the second floor.

Q: Do I need to bring my own lunch or can I buy food or drink at the job fair?

A: There are restaurants available to purchase food and drink or you may bring your own. No storage or refrigeration available.

Q: Will there be computers, printers, or copy machines at the fair for me to use?

A: No.

Q: Will there be wireless Internet access at the fair? Can I bring a laptop and get to the Internet?

A: No wireless access will be provided.
