

**CLAYTON STATE UNIVERSITY 2010 SNOW SKI ADVENTURE  
QUESTIONS & ANSWERS**

**General Questions About the Trip**

- 1 Q: Why is the trip over winter break?  
A: Two reasons: 1) You don't have to worry about classes, and 2) There will be less people on the slopes so more ski time for you!
- 2 Q: Why should I go on this trip?  
A: This is the BEST trip all year and the one you will remember the rest of your life. You will have a GREAT time - we promise!
- 3 Q: What does the package include?  
A: Transportation, Lodging (3 nights), Ski rental (2 days), lift ticket (2 days), continental breakfast.
- 4 Q: Who pays for the food?  
A: In order to keep the trip price down, we decided against buying meal vouchers. So, you pay for your own food. Feel free to bring snacks with you. There are plenty of restaurants near the resort.
- 5 Q: What if I don't know how to ski?  
A: No worries! For \$18, you get a one-hour ski lesson. Lots of people do this.
- 6 Q: Are there other options than skiing?  
A: For an additional fee, you can snow board (\$40) or snow blade (\$20). Or, you can go tubing which does not cost anything extra.
- 7 Q: What if I just want to go and don't want to ski or anything?  
A: You can! It will be a lot cheaper for you too!
- 8 Q: What if I would like to change up activities and ski one day and blade the next?  
A: This is an option but you will need to personally take care of paying any up-charges for that at the resort.
- 9 Q: Can we drink alcohol?  
A: If you are of legal drinking age, we can't stop you. However, you are still responsible for your conduct. All CSU Code of Conduct rules still apply to University sponsored events. You will be held accountable.
- 10 Q: Why West Virginia?  
A: We don't have to worry about not having real snow. Previous trips to North Carolina have been hit and miss with the snow.

**The Resort is the Fairfield Inn - NICE!**

- 11 Q: What are the hotel rooming options?  
A: You can select a room for two friends (double) or four friends (quad).
- 12 Q: Can girls and guys room together?  
A: Rooms will be assigned to all males or all females unless a couple is married.

- 13 Q: How can I room with my friends?  
A: Be sure to tell us their name when you sign up. Be sure that they are in agreement!

**Transportation - The Coach Bus has TVs & DVD Players. Also has a restroom. VERY NICE!**

- 14 Q: How long does it take to get to the Resort?  
A: About 7 or 8 hours not including rest stops. Bring books, DVDs, and headphones.
- 15 Q: What time will we return on Sunday?  
A: We'll plan to depart around 11 am so once we load the bus, stop to eat lunch, we should be back by 7 pm.

**Payment Questions**

- 16 Q: When is the money due?  
A: A \$100 deposit is due at sign-up and it is non-refundable. Why? Because we have to pay a non-refundable deposit to the company.
- 17 Q: Can I make payments toward the trip?  
A: Yes. We will accept partial payments along the way until you have your invoice paid in full provided you meet the **November 17 deadline**.
- 18 Q: What happens if I pay for the trip and then for some reason I cannot go?  
A: Find someone to take your place on the trip. Once your sub pays for the trip, we will process your refund (less your deposit).
- 19 Q: When is the balance of the money due?  
A: Your trip balance will be due on **Tuesday, November 17, 2009**.
- 20 Q: What methods of payment do you take?  
A: Check, cash, or charge.
- 21 Q: Where do I pay?  
A: All payments are taken at the front desk of the Student Activities Center. Increments of \$50 or more would be appreciated.
