### **Clientele**

The Clayton State University Library serves the academic community of currently enrolled students, faculty, staff, administrators, and visiting researchers.

### **Policy**

The library provides an adult, unsupervised environment for the purpose of academic research and support of the University's curriculum. Children cannot be monitored and supervised by staff; therefore, the safety of unattended children cannot be guaranteed.

Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or an adult guardian at all times.

### **Violation of Policy**

Public Safety will be notified of any unattended children in the library.
