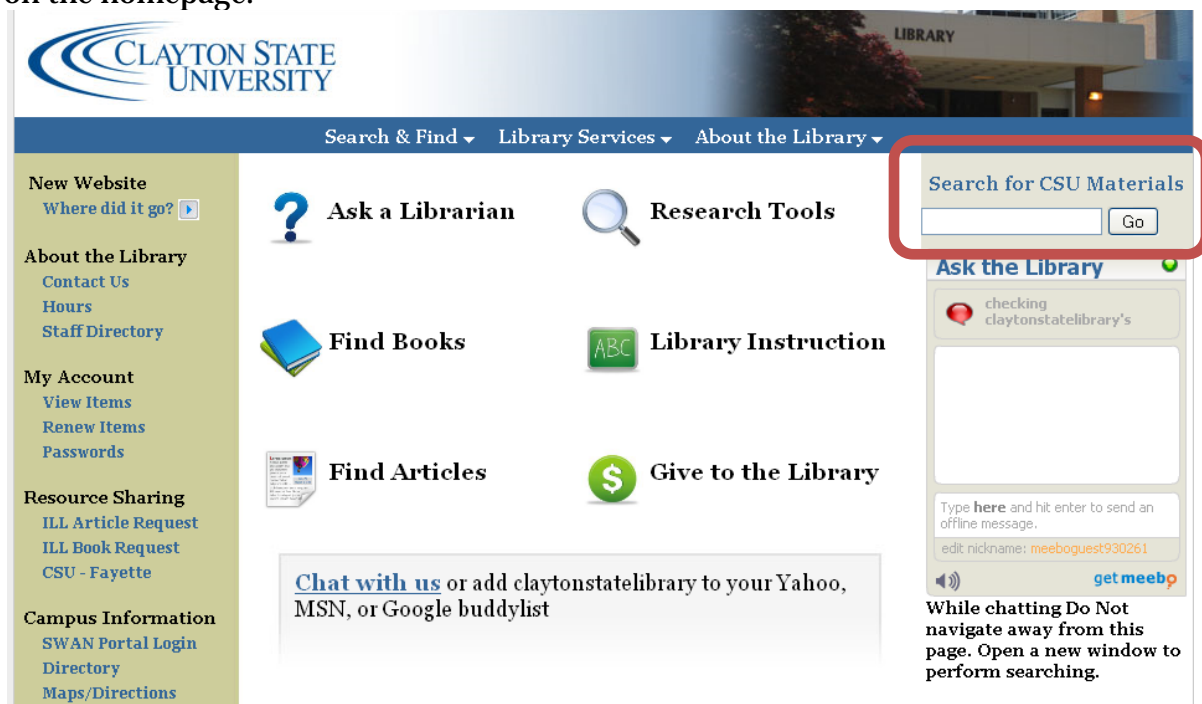

What happened to GIL?

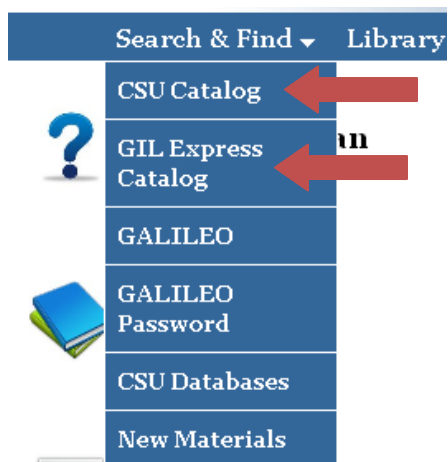
The easiest way to perform a keyword search is to use the *Search for CSU Materials* box on the homepage.

Search WorldCat.org for books that are available from all types of libraries worldwide. Use [Interlibrary Loan](#) to request these titles to be delivered to Clayton State.



Search the PINES catalog for books that are available from public libraries. Use [Interlibrary Loan](#) to request these titles to be delivered to Clayton State.



Search NetLibrary for full-text electronic books 24 hours a day, seven days a week. First time users will need to create a free account.
