Status	Concern / Issue	Actions Taken
Resolved	Spivey Walkway: Too fast going around curve. Pedestrians not visible	Cut bushes down to see pedestrians. Added pedestrian crossing signs. Added speed bumps.
Resolved	Fragrant candles and open flame.	No CSU policy states we cannot have candles, but will be advised not to for safety reasons.
Resolved	Student Center lobby has no seating for visitors.	Area is still under renovation and will have available seating when completed. Temporary seating has been put in place until then.
Resolved	Outdoor seating at University Center.	An experimental outdoor table was put outside. There is positive feedback for more. Plans are to get more in the future.
Resolved	Geese population and geese droppings	Geese were safely removed and relocated, but this process does not eliminate geese population as more come in. Still exploring ways to control population and droppings
Resolved	Stray animals at Student Center loading dock.	An article on not setting food out for them will be put in Laker Lines. Animal Control won't come pick them up unless they are captured.
